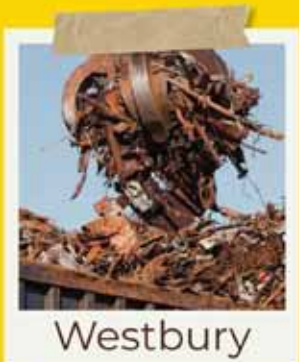

How to enter the Horticulture & Crafts Show

- We prefer entries to be made online at www.corsleyfayre.org.uk (follow the link in the Horticulture and Crafts section) as it significantly cuts down our admin time, but if you don't have online access, please use the form on the previous page.
- **Online entries** must be made by **11pm on Wednesday 26th August**.
- **Paper entries** must be made by **4pm on Wednesday 26th August**.
- Paper entry forms can be dropped off at the till areas at either Acres Supply (Corsley) or Barters Plant Centre (Chapmanslade).
- One exhibitor per paper entry form (please feel free to photocopy this form if you need another copy or if you need more lines to enter).
- Don't forget to make a copy of what you've entered!
- **Please note the different deadlines for online and paper entries!**

Horticulture and Crafts Show Rules

- All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor and in the case of vegetables, fruit and flowers in Divisions A and B, must have been in his or her own cultivation prior to the day of the Fayre.
- To comply with Health & Safety rules, all food items should be covered.
- All exhibits, where applicable, shall be displayed in or on containers supplied by the exhibitor except for the Photography and Art classes where boards will be supplied.
- The judges' decisions in Divisions A, B, E and H will be final.
- Certificates will be awarded at 3pm. **No exhibits may be removed before 5pm.**
- The Society will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur to exhibits. Artwork and photographs are only covered by our insurance for reproduction costs.

Note

- The Horticulture and Crafts marquee will be open to receive exhibits on Saturday 29th August from 8am until 9am when judging of Divisions A, B, E and H will commence. The public will 'vote' for the best/their favourite exhibit in Divisions C, D, F, G using tokens.
- Please don't be late with your entries!! The marquee will be cleared of exhibitors at 9am prompt to allow judging of Divisions A, B and E, H to commence.
- Exhibitor cards will be available from a central point in the H&C marquee from 8am to until 9am on the day of the Fayre. Please place your exhibitor card face down next to your exhibit.
- Preserves (marmalade, jam, jelly, curd, etc) should fill, to no more than 1cm from the brim, a 1lb/454g plain glass jam jar and should be sealed with either a new twist-top lid or a waxed disc and a cellophane cover, secured with an elastic band and be labelled with the name of the preserve and dated. Jars not filled correctly will be disqualified.
